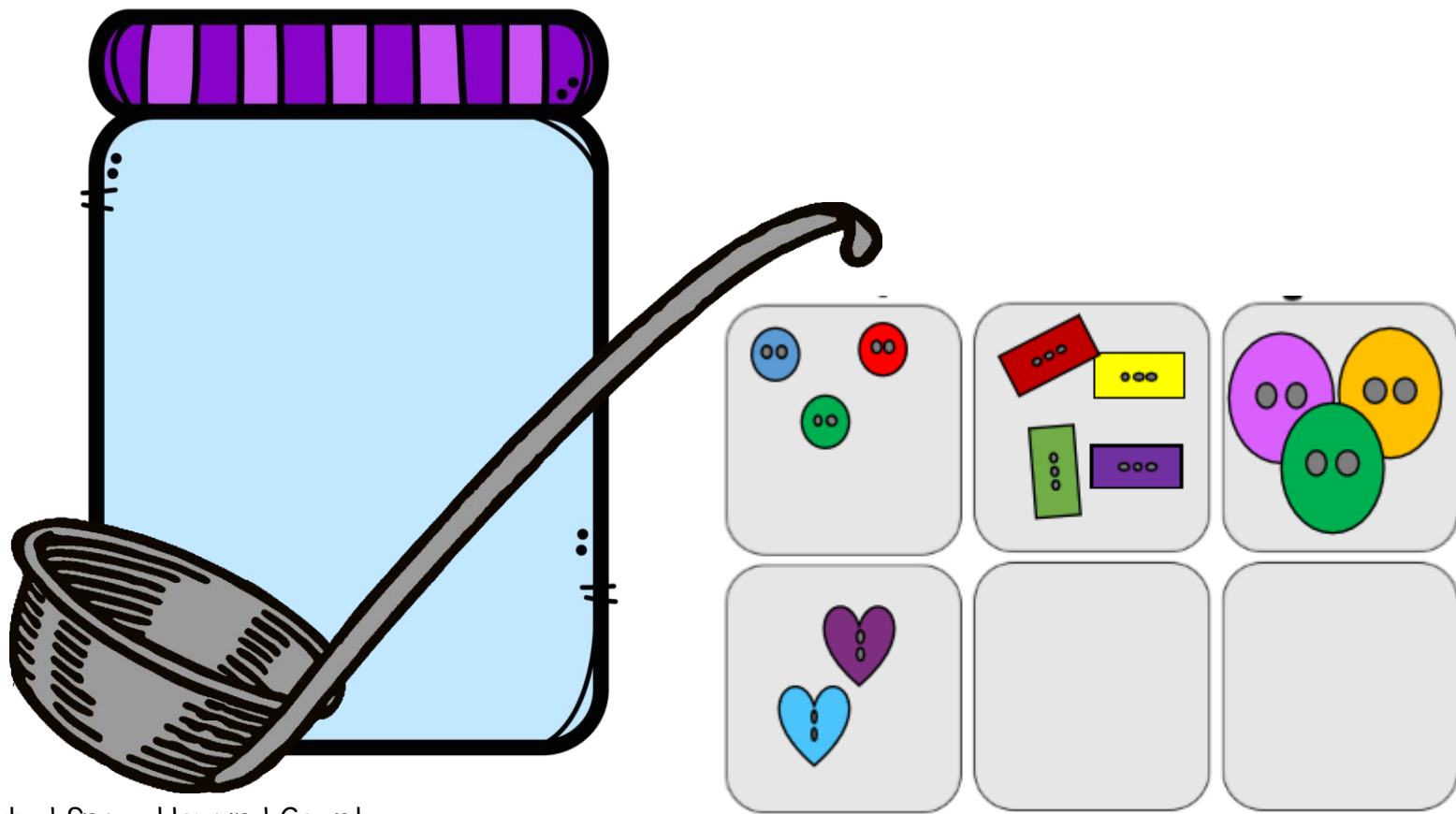


Button Scoop

Button Scoop

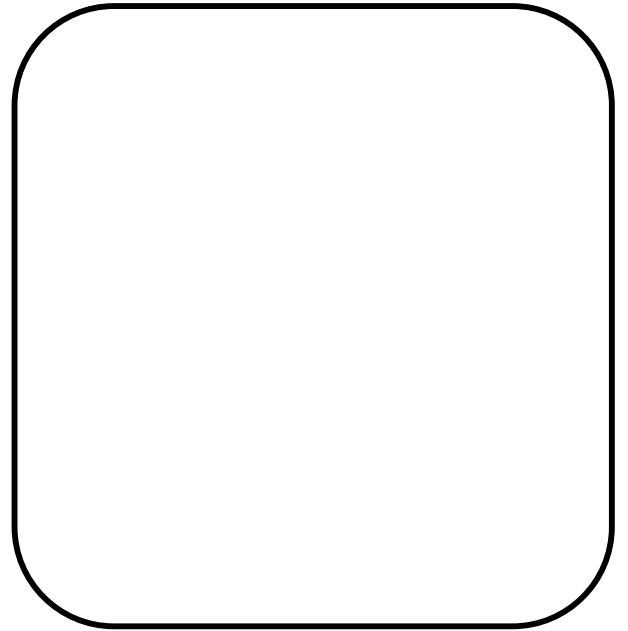
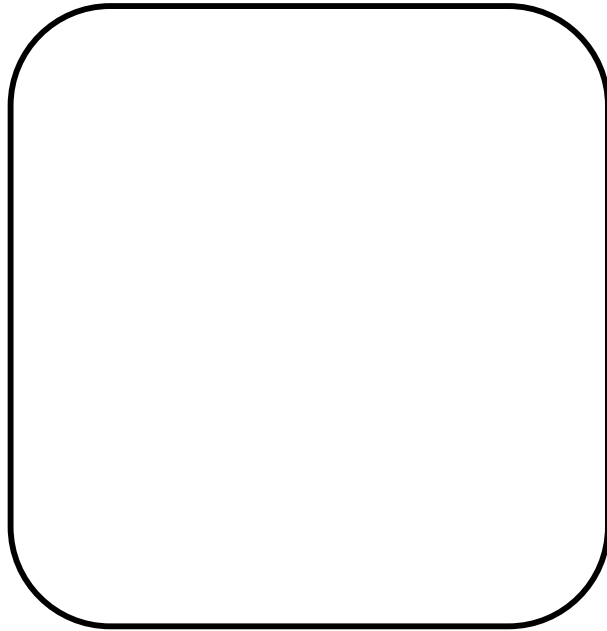
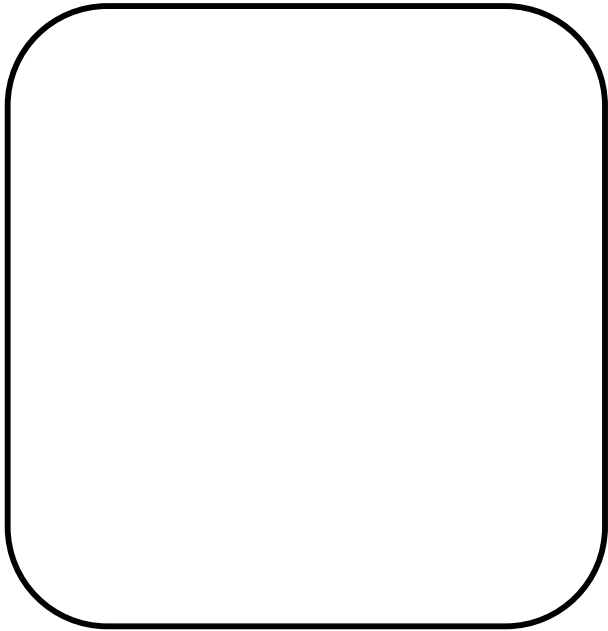
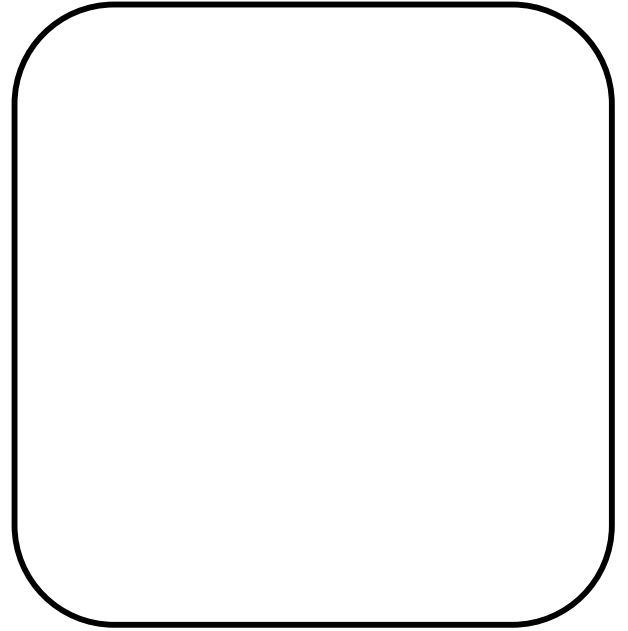
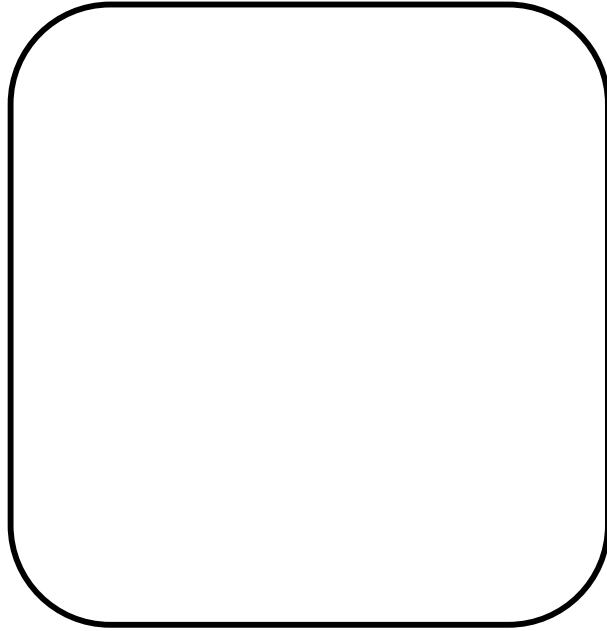
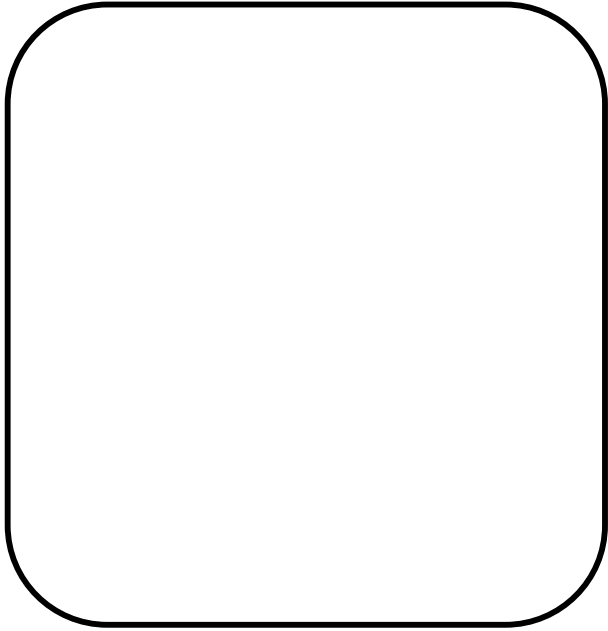
Materials:

- Assorted buttons
- Scoopers or ladles (optional)
- Recording sheet

Directions:

- 1) Scoop some buttons from the container. Use a scooper or your hands.
- 2) Sort the buttons. Place each group of buttons in a box on the sorting mat. You do not need to use all of the buttons.
- 3) Count how many groups you created.
- 4) Count how many buttons are in each group.
- 5) Return all of the buttons to the container. Mix the buttons up and go again.
