


Back and Forth Counting Race



Counting Race

Materials:

- Number cube or die
- One game piece to be shared by both students.

Directions:

1. Players decide which direction they will move their pieces on the game board. Player one always moves left, and player two always moves right. The game piece is placed on the square labeled, "Start".
2. Players decide who goes first. That player rolls the die or number cube and moves that many spaces in his/her direction.
3. The second player rolls the die and moves the game piece that many spaces in his/her direction. (ex. If player one rolls 2, she moves the game piece two spaces to the left. Then player two rolls a 4. She now moves the game piece 4 spaces to the right.)
4. Player one wins the game if the game piece is moved to the "end" box on the bottom left corner of the board. Player two wins if the game piece is moved to the "end" box on the bottom right corner of the board.
