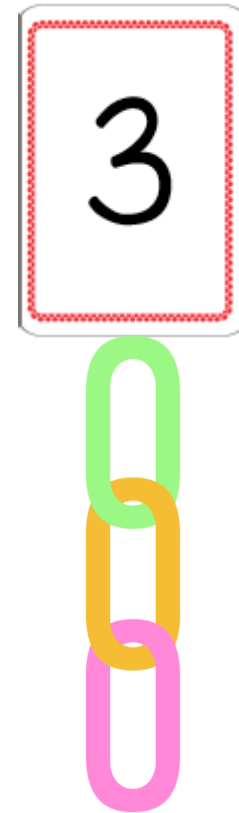
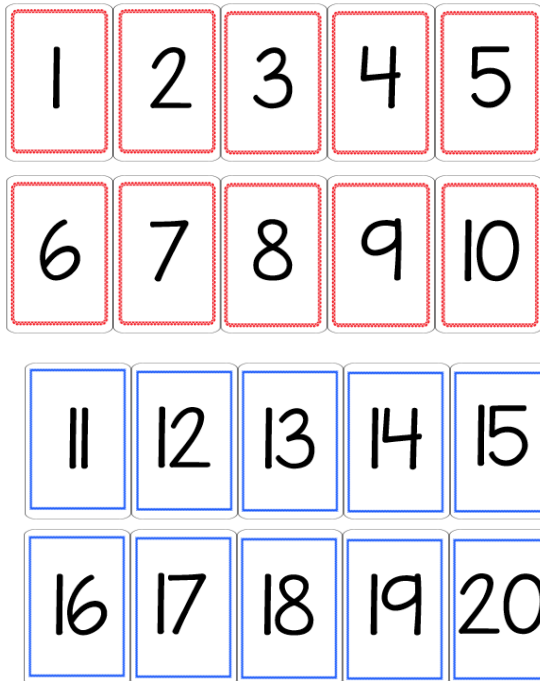
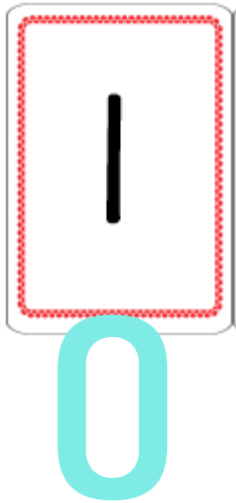


Counting with Linking Chains 1 - 20



Counting with Linking Chains

Materials:

- Linking chain number cards (With a hole puncher, make a hole towards the bottom of each card, so students can attach the first linking chain to the card.)
- Linking chain pieces

Directions:

1. Students choose a number card and attach that many linking chains to the card. (Ex, If the 2 card is chosen, the student puts two linking chain pieces together and attaches them to the card. If 10 is chosen, the student will make a longer chain of 10 and attach the chain to the card.)

Option:

Based on the needs of the students, the teacher may choose specific numbers for the students to practice counting. Ex. Some students may be counting 1 - 5, while others are practicing with all of the numbers 1 - 10.
