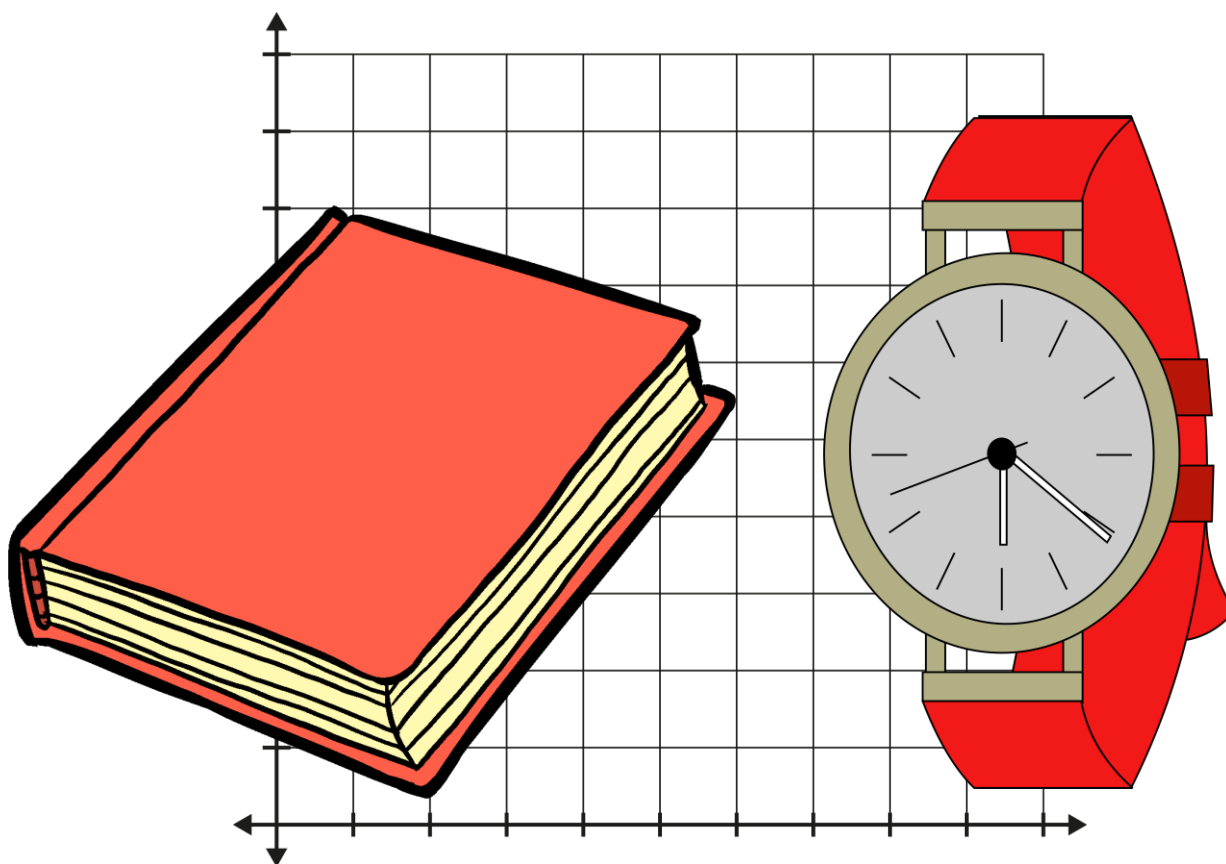


How Many Pages?

How Many Pages?

Materials:

- Coordinate grid paper
- Book
- Stopwatch
- Math Journal

Directions:

- 1) Collect data on the number of pages you read in five minute intervals for 30 minutes. Create a two-column chart. Record your starting page number at 0 minutes.
- 2) Record your page number after reading for 5, 10, 15, 20, 25, and 30 minutes.
- 3) Create a coordinate grid to graph your data. Use an appropriate scale. Label the axes and write a title.
- 4) Write the related pairs of data as ordered pairs. Plot a point for each ordered pair.
- 5) Choose one point on your graph and write the ordered pair that describes its location. Explain how the coordinates in the ordered pair are related.
- 6) Analyze your data. What conclusions can you draw? Record your thinking.
