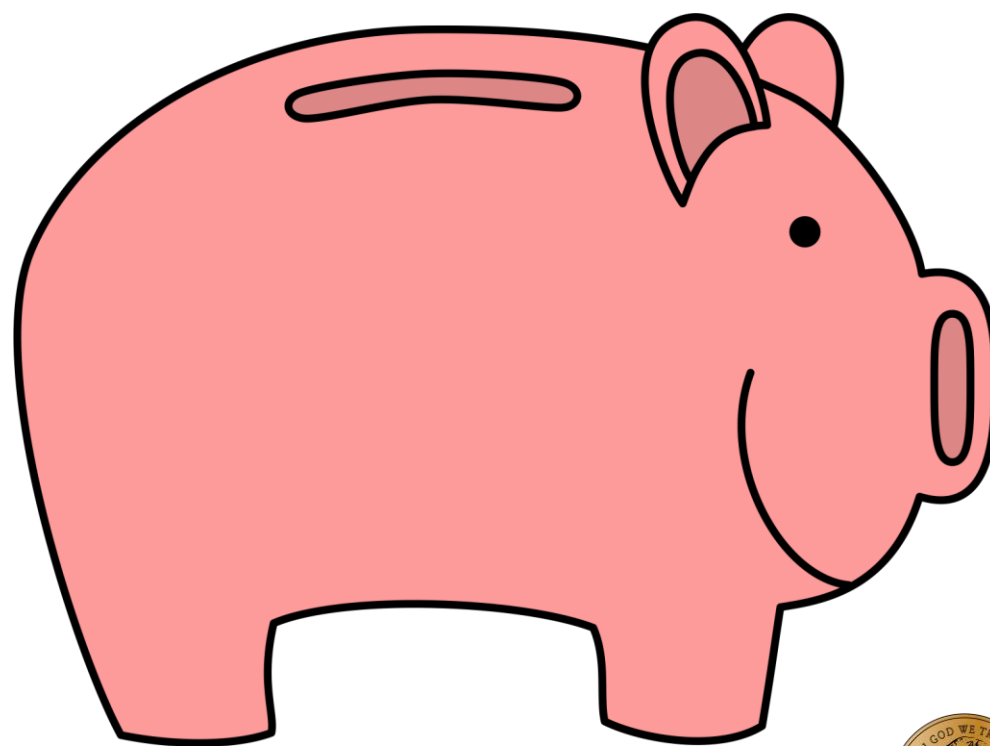

Fair Share Division Activity

Materials:

- 100 pennies
- Hundred chart (cut apart)
- 10 piggy banks

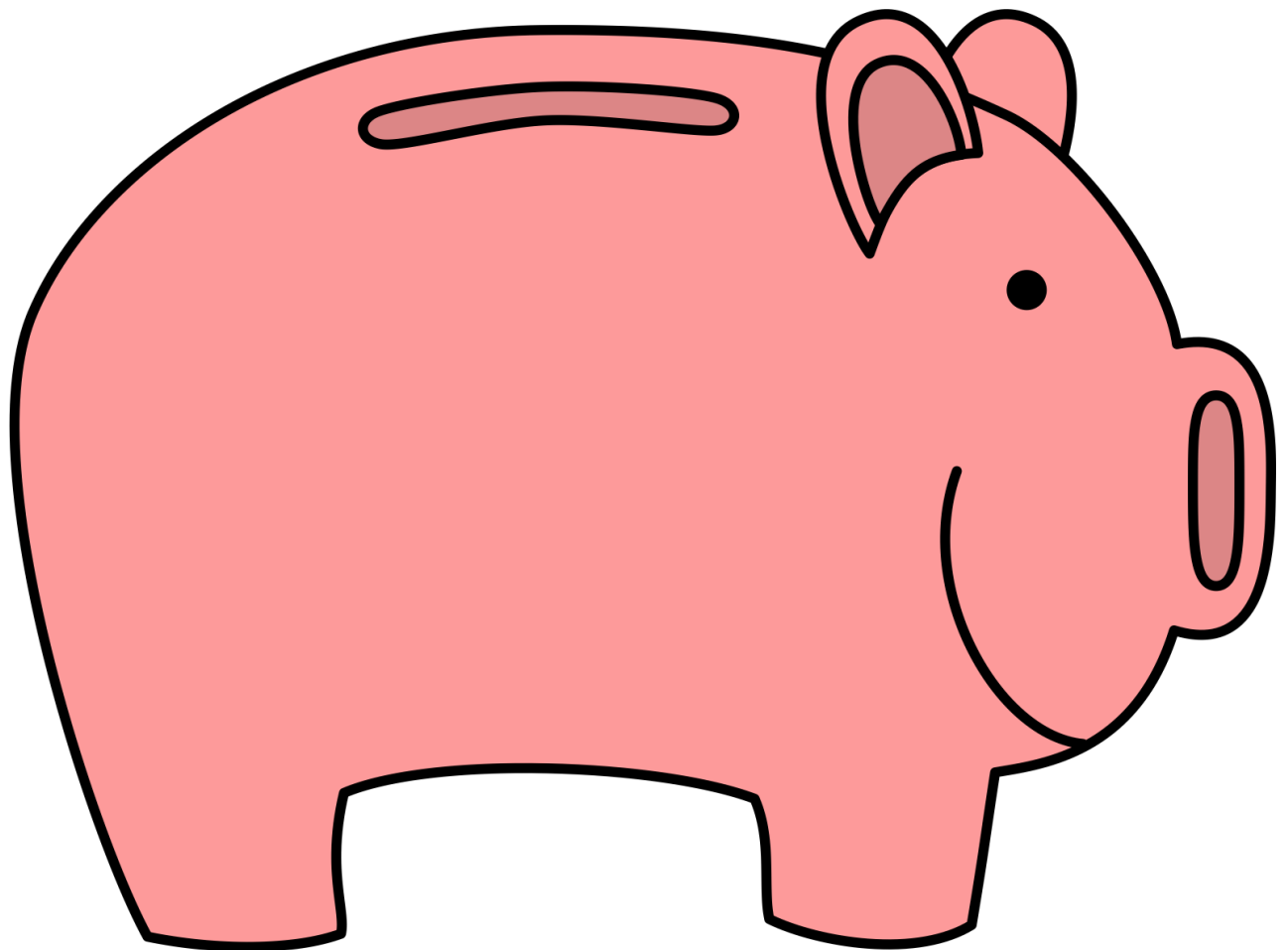
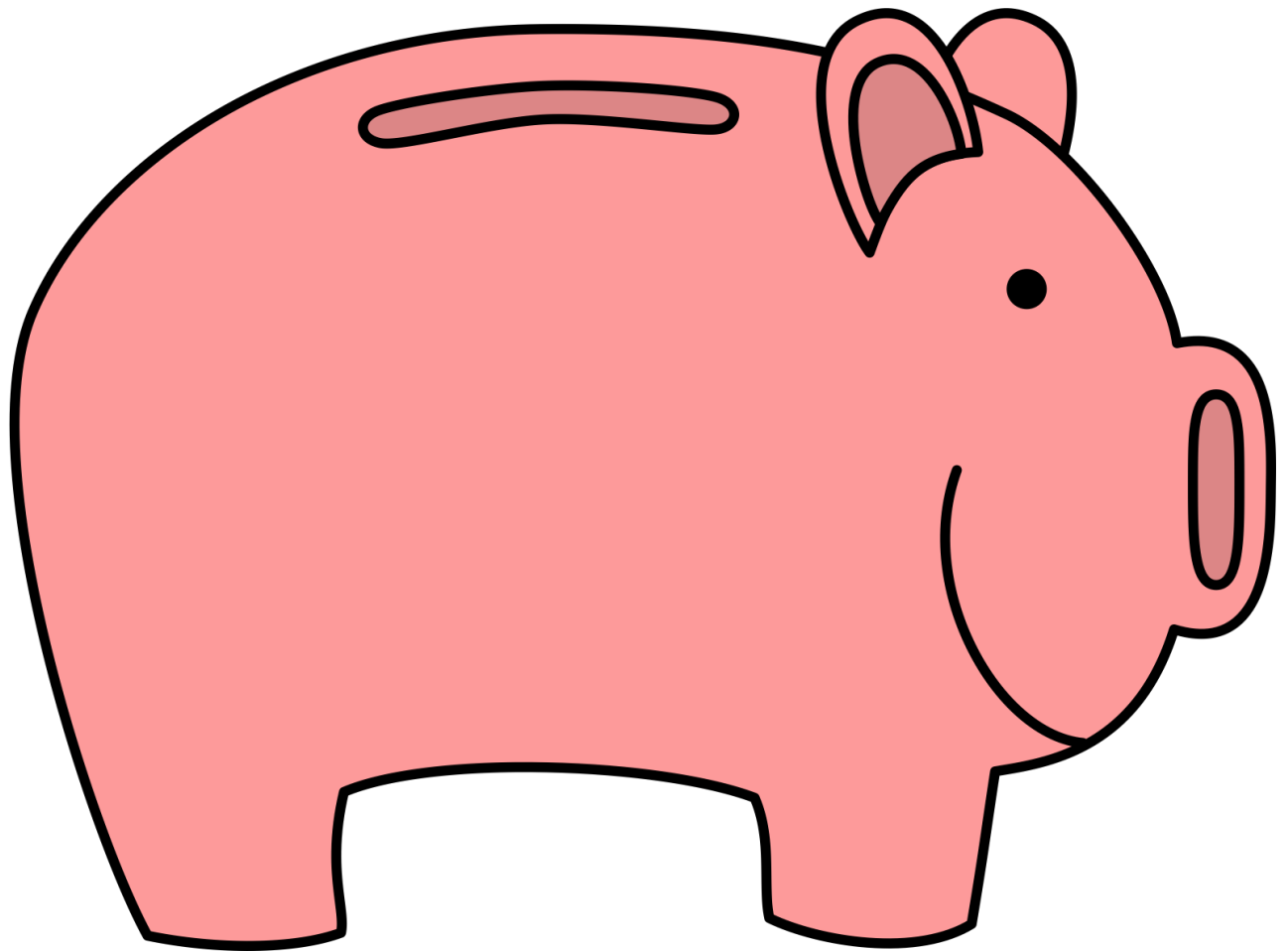
Directions:

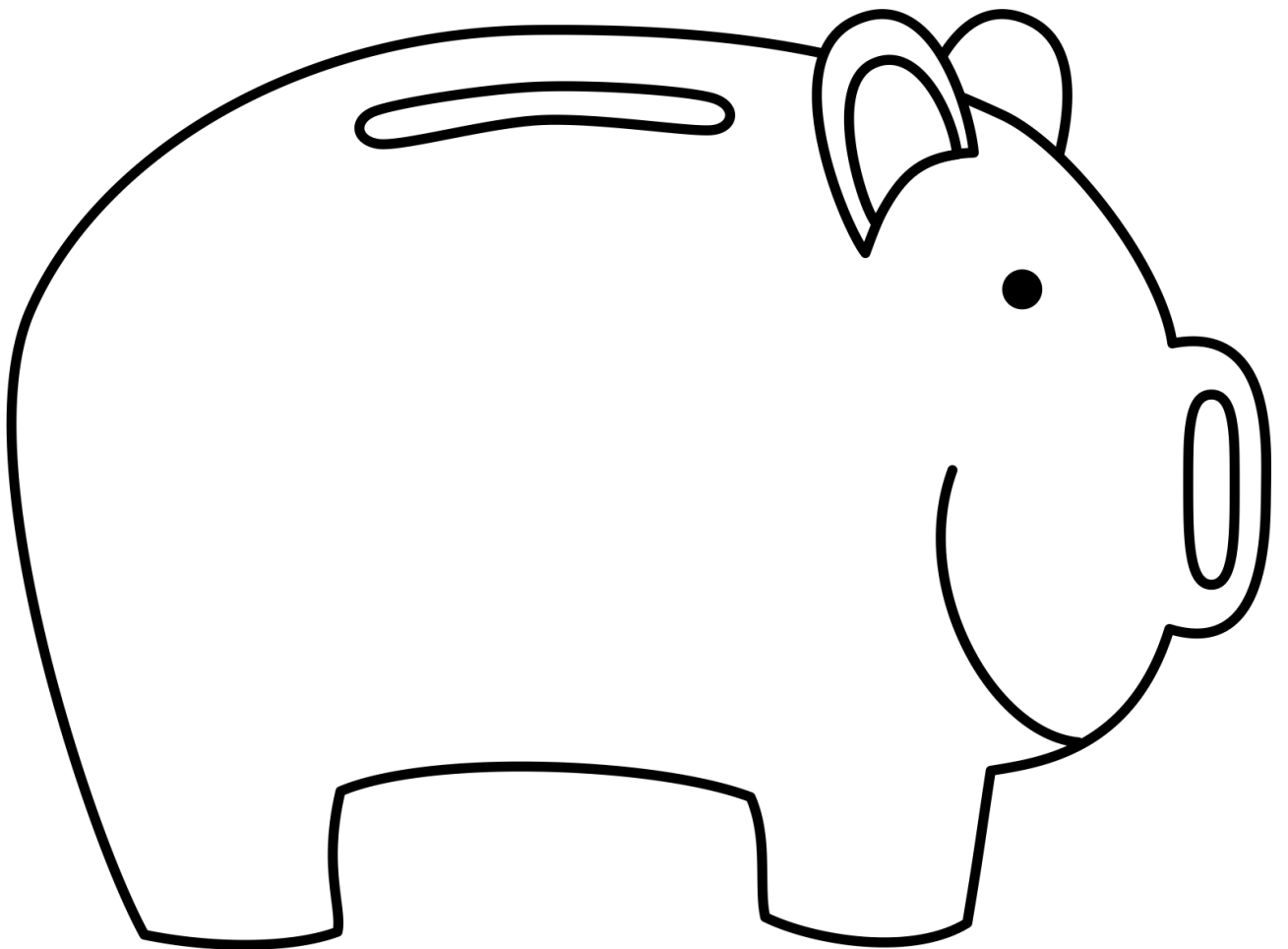
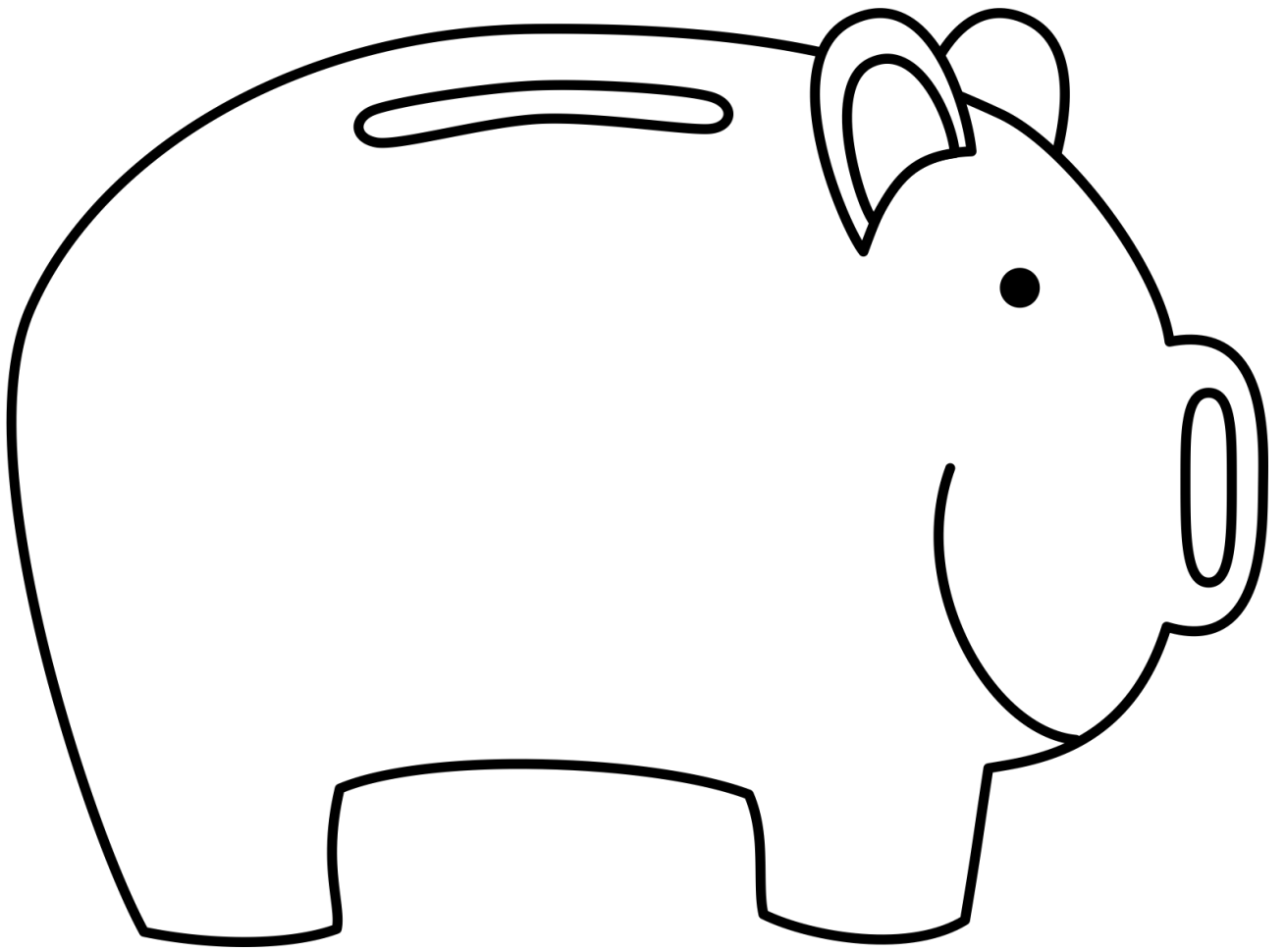
- 1) Player 1 chooses a number card from the cup. The number is the dividend. He gathers that many pennies.
- 2) Player one decides how many piggy banks to use to try to have fair shares. He lays out the piggy banks.
- 3) Player 1 then distributes the pennies in equal amounts, one at a time to each bank.
- 4) If he distributed fair shares, there will be no pennies left over. If there is a remainder, the partners decide if a different number of piggy banks could have been used and try it.

Variations:

Use only numbers that are multiples of 2, 5, and 10.
